Literacy Program

Each year the FOL funds a literacy program for the First Grade classes in both Sherrills Ford and Catawba Elementary Schools. This year, we read five books to each class: *Not So Tall* by Dianna Aston; *Bunny Loves to Write* by Peter Bentley; *One Starry Night* by Christina Butler; *Reuben and the Blizzard* by Merle Good; and *Froggy Goes to Hawaii* by Jonathan London. These books then become part of the classroom book collection.

The book is read to the classes and then sent home with each child along with a journal to write in, and a letter to parents about reading with their children -- all in a special bag. Our librarians make an individual bookmark for each child with suggestions of similar books to find in the library. This program hopes to connect the library, school and home in encouraging reading and writing.

The children are always eager when we come to read. A big thank you to Vonda Freeman, who helped to read this year! We hope to read our first book in our new library next school year!
